Northbound on Highway 97: Go north on Hwy 97 to Veterans way (light) and turn left. See Veterans Way directions.

Southbound on Highway 97: Go south on Hwy 97 remaining on the Hwy. 97 bypass to Veterans way (light) and turn right. See Veteran's way directions.

Eastbound on Highway 126: Go east on Hwy 126 (Sisters Hwy/Highland Ave.) to the intersection with SW 6th Street. Turn right on SW 6th Street. Move to the left lane and go approx. 0.1 mile to Kalama. Turn right onto Kalama and right into the Grange parking lot.

Veterans Way Directions: After turning onto Veterans Way, proceed to the signal at S. Canal Blvd. Turn right (north) onto S. Canal Blvd. and go approx. 0.1 mile to Kalama (just past Lowes). Turn left (west) onto Kalama and right into the Grange parking lot.

About our guest teacher: Elisa Chandler

Elisa has been involved in many types of dance throughout her life, but Scottish Country Dancing is one of her greatest joys. She started down the Scottish Country Dance path about 26 years ago after becoming a member of a dance group, Dancing in the Isles, that performed at the Arizona Renaissance Festival. She became a member of the Phoenix (AZ) RSCDS Branch and their demonstration team. The teachers of this branch emphasized technique and this formal foundation has allowed her to continue to build upon her skills as she learns new formations and dances.

After moving to Oregon in 2006, Elisa has been dancing with the Eugene Scottish Dancers and enjoys being a part of their demo team. She is a member of Ceili of the Valley, which is based in Salem, teaching their Tuesday night classes. She teaches a mix of Irish Ceili dances, Scottish Country dances, and dances from other Celtic Nations. She leads the Ceili of the Valley demo team. She and her husband, Richard, live in Shedd (south of Albany) and are happy commuters to their different dance classes and presentations.

A Scottish Heart

has been teaming up with Bend's Scottish dancers since 1994. The two groups have developed their arts, as well as community awareness of Scottish dancing and culture. Fiddle, piano, and bodhran, plus the occasional bagpipe, and penny whistle, makes foot-stepping tunes and rhythms come to life in dancers' feet.
