## My Little Buttercup

32-bar strathspey for three couples in a three-couple longwise set

## Bars

## Description

1-2 1st and 2nd couples dance right hands across halfway round while 3 rd couple, giving right hands, cross over.
3-4 2nd, 1st, and 3rd couples set.
5-8 All three couples, giving right hands, cross over and set.
9-12 1st woman with 2 nd couple and 1 st man with 3rd couple dance right hands across once round, 1 st couple passing by the right at the end.
13-16 1st man with 2nd couple and 1st woman with 3rd couple dance left hands across once round.

17-24 2nd, 1st and 3rd couples dance an arandel, finishing with 1st couple facing out, without the polite turn.

25-32 2nd, 1st, and 3rd couples dance a chaperoned chain progression.
Repeat from new positions.
Note: the arandel, pronounced "are-an-dell", is a form of rights and lefts for three couples in 8 bars, and is normally danced as follows:

1-2 2nd, 1st and 3rd couples, giving right hands to partner, cross over to change sides.
3-4 2nd man and 3rd woman set to each other.
2 nd and 1 st women, giving left hands, change places on the sideline.
1 st and 3 rd men, giving left hands, change places on the sideline.
5-6 All three couples, giving right hands to the dancer opposite, cross over to change sides.
7-8 2nd man and 3rd woman set.
1 st and 2 nd women, giving left hands, change places on the sideline.
3rd and 1st men, giving left hands, change places on the sideline.
All three couples are now back in their original places.
On bar 8,1 st couple pull back by the left to dance into place (polite turn).
